Monday, August 13, 2018: Harold A. Henry Park, 7:00 pm

I. WELCOMING REMARKS

A. Call to Order

A duly noticed meeting of the Windsor Village Association Board's Community Meeting was held on Monday, August 13, 2018 in Harold A. Henry Park.

A quorum was present. The President, Barbara Pflaumer called the meeting to order at 7:20 PM.

Special Guest: Councilman David Ryu, CD4

Councilman Ryu spoke to the community stating that community crime and homeless issues remain the biggest issues facing CD4. Ryu stated that he had been working with the Los Angeles Police Department to get additional patrol cars on the streets. Ryu addressed the homeless issue and discussed two projects underway to help ease the homeless situation. One is a job training program and another a program to add 230 beds in the city for the homeless.

Barbara Pflaumer opened the question portion asking for Ryu's take on recent reports of at least 52 real estate development projects proposed or under construction in nearby Koreatown. Ryu explained with the housing crunch it is hard to know where to build and planning officials think of Koreatown like downtown LA – a higher density area. Other topic included overnight parking, clean up teams, city Waze app, myla311, bike paths, and food waste programs.
